

WARNING - Risk of Fire and Electric Shock:

2. For Indoor and Outdoor Use.
3. Do not place near gas or electric heaters, radiators, fireplaces, candles, barbeques or other similar sources of heat.
4. Place on a level, hard, flat surface; do not place where tree is likely to wobble due to uneven floors or thick carpeting.
5. Do not use candles on lamp post.
6. After assembling the tree and adding decorations, make sure the lamp post is stable. If lamp post is not stable, shift the weight of the decorations, and use support wires to walls and/or window frames (make sure they are secure also).
7. Do not overload extension cords or power strips, see ratings on those devices and check the rating labels on the lamp post for compatibility.
8. Do not install near fountains, bathtubs, sinks, pools or other areas of standing water.
9. Only use this product with extension cords rated for indoor and outdoor use.
